Competition held under British Ice Skating (BIS) Regulations and Permit

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

- The competition will be held in Edinburgh on Monday 27 January 2020 & will take place in Murrayfield Ice Rink
- The competition will be judged using the International Judging System. All competitions will be run in accordance with ISU criteria for the 2019 /2020 season. Skaters and their coaches are strongly advised to read all the relevant communications and criteria.
- All competitors must be ready to skate 30 minutes before the time stated on the timetable
- All timetables are provisional and may be subject to change

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All entries must meet the minimum requirements set out below – and be age eligible for the event entered.

Standard of skater is at closing date

- BASIC NOVICE LADIES
Level 4 Field Moves + Competitive Level 4 or Level 4 Elements +/- Free
- INTERMEDIATE NOVICE LADIES
Level 6 Field Moves + Competitive Level 6 or Level 6 Elements +/- Free
- BASIC NOVICE MEN
Level 4 Field Moves + Competitive Level 4 or Level 4 Elements +/- Free
- INTERMEDIATE NOVICE MEN
Level 6 Field Moves + Competitive Level 6 or Level 6 Elements +/- Free

HOW TO ENTER

All entries must contain:

- Completed entry form including Program Content Sheet
- Full Payment of £60 should be paid via bank transfer to Skate Edinburgh

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Competition will cover ISU Categories Basic & Intermediate Novice in Singles for Ladies and Men only.
- All skaters meeting age & level criteria are welcome to apply however **ONLY ONE entry per person will be accepted (please choose basic OR intermediate level if eligible for both)**
- Incomplete entries will not be accepted
- NO late entries will be accepted
- All competitors must be members of British Ice Skating. Competitors with lapsed membership will be withdrawn at time of draw and will not receive a refund.
- All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102
- Application is by email only to SkateEdinburgh@gmail.com
- Skate Edinburgh will acknowledge receipt of correctly and fully completed entry form by sending a confirmation e-mail to the skater. This will be done within 5 days of receipt. Anyone who does not receive this should query BEFORE the closing date.
- Please note, confirmation of entry does not guarantee the skater a place
- **Skate Edinburgh reserves the right to reject entries without assigning a reason. All decisions are final. If the event is oversubscribed priority will be given to skaters who have not already achieved the minimum TES to be able to compete in the British Ice Skating March Qualifier**
- The organizers of the competition retain the right of decision on all matters, their decision being final.
- Anyone we are unable to accommodate will be issued with a full refund. Any withdrawals before closing date are subject to a £15 admin fee. Withdrawals after closing date are non-refundable

PRACTICE ICE

Practice sessions may be available at this event and will be announced after the closing date if applicable. Practice sessions are optional and will incur an additional charge.

DRAWS

All Draws will take place prior to the event by random draw. Details of draw will be published as soon as possible after the closing date.

ON THE DAY

- **MUSIC**
Music must be recorded on CDs and must be handed over to organizers at registration. The music must be of a superior quality and labelled clearly with the name of competitors, their category and duration of the music. Please make sure you have a spare CD ice side.
- **ACCREDITATION**
Official accreditation will be available in the ice rink on arrival. Only BIS registered coaches with relevant seminars who have been named on the entry form will be given accreditation to be ice side for the event.
- **FILMING & PHOTOGRAPHY**
Personal filming or photography is NOT permitted, and anyone found to be doing so will be removed from the building.
- **CONDUCT**
Competitors, parents and coaches are reminded that the organizers, judges, officials and helpers are all volunteers without whom this competition would not be possible. Failure to treat them with respect will result in the individual being expelled from the event.
- **ANTI DOPING**
These competitions may be subject to doping control under BIS rules and by the ISU.
- **PRESENTATIONS**
Presentations will take place at the end of skating each day, or at suitable points during the day should time allow.



LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for loss, injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials. Skate Edinburgh & Murrayfield Skating Academy will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Skate Edinburgh, Murrayfield Skating Academy, Murrayfield Ice Rink and British Ice Skating cannot be held responsible for events outside of their control eg. Power failure etc. In these circumstances none of the organisations will be held responsible for expenses incurred by competitors.
